How does this delay my DSRB application?

 DSRB is unable to determine if the PI has available insurance coverage to provide payment and compensation to research subjects for any injury or illness arising from their participation in the study.



Study Funding Information

The PI should ensure that insurance coverage is available for subjects. (ROAM guidebook)

- All Investigator-initiated studies conducted within NHG and public healthcare institutions are covered under the National Clinical Trial Group Insurance policy.
- Industry-Sponsored studies should ensure insurance coverage from the sponsor.
- You may contact your Research Office/ Clinical Research Unit for more information on insurance coverage options for your study.



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Study Funding Information

Section E2: Please give information regarding the study's funding source or sponsor information.
