NHG Standing Database / Tissue Bank Registration Head of Department Endorsement Guidebook Version 1

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1. Overview of the Standing Database / Tissue Bank Endorsement Process

The online application will automatically be routed to the respective endorsing authority/authorities for the necessary endorsement(s), as follows:

Department(s) Involved	Institution(s) Involved	Endorsing Authority
One department	One institution	Custodian's HOD
More than one department	One institution	Custodian's CMB
		CMBs of all institutions
More than one department	More than one institution	involved

2. Role of the Head of Department (HOD)

As the respective institutions own standing databases / tissue banks set up by their staff members, the HOD will be the owner of standing databases / tissue banks created within his/her department. The standing database / tissue bank application must be supported and endorsed online by the Custodian's HOD before it is forwarded to DSRB for review and acknowledgement.

3. Where to see your Endorsement Tasks

After logging into the NHG ROAM portal, HODs will see their endorsement tasks on their homepage. Upon completing the task, the list will be automatically updated and the task removed.




By clicking on the blue hyperlinked text, HODs will be shown a table of tasks pending their endorsement.



By clicking on the reference number of the standing database / tissue bank application, the HOD will be able to access the submission details from the Custodian (click on View Submission), as well as see the endorsement options available to them.

Endorsement Options

1. **Endorse Application** – This option indicates the support of the HOD for the Standing Database / Tissue Bank application. To endorse, the HOD must check the declaration that he/she acknowledges full ownership of the standing database / tissue bank and that he/she agrees to the appointment of the Custodian and click submit.




This is the notification screen when the application has been successfully endorsed.



2. **Reject Application** – This option indicates that the HOD does not support the standing database / tissue bank application. Before clicking 'submit', a reason must be provided for the rejection, and this will be made available to the Custodian.

Note: Once the application has been rejected, the decision cannot be reversed. The Custodian will have to submit a fresh application.
