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

Introduction to NHG Research Quality Management





HBRA Requirement

Scope of Research Institution (RI) Responsibilities Sections 23, 24 ✓ Supervise, review & proactively monitor the safe and ethical conduct of the research

> Must be in Singapore & have at least 2 individuals ordinarily resident in Singapore

Notify MOH before the commencement of any HBR

✓ Annual declaration of compliance

Report Serious Adverse Events





✓Appoint at least one IRB to review the HBR under its supervision & be responsible for its proper functioning & decision making

✓ Establish a data and safety monitoring board if the IRB considers that it is necessary

✓ Appoint Person-In-Charge, develop internal policies, standards and systems for the proper conduct of any HBR under its supervision

Objectives

The objectives of the NHG Monitoring Programme for HBR studies are to:

i. Safeguard the **safety and well-being** of the research participants;

ii. Ensure good quality and integrity of the research data;


iii. Ensure the **conduct** of the study is in accordance to applicable regulations, policies and guidelines; and to

iv. Fulfill the **responsibility** of the RI according to HBRA

Risk-based approach





Extent of monitoring

For studies conducted in **NHG Institutions**:

Risk Category	Criteria	Mode of Monitoring	Frequency
2В	Expedited studiesNo waiver of ConsentNew PI	PI Self-Monitoring (Mandatory)	Once
3A	 Full Board studies Restricted HBR Vulnerable Population Devices* Surgical Procedures PI 1st Full Board study 	On-site + Remote Monitoring	 Site Initiation Visit Yearly monitoring visits 3 or 6 monthly remote monitoring
3B	All other Full Board studies	PI Self-monitoring + On-site Monitoring (Selected at random)	 6 or 12 monthly Self-Monitoring One-time on-site monitoring visit for selected studies

^{*}Unregistered or registered with HSA under Class B, C or D.

o Studies with Industry-Monitoring available will not be selected under this Programme.

O Studies may be upgraded/ downgraded in their risk category subject to certain conditions.

Mode of Monitoring

PI Self-Monitoring

• Using NHG RQM PI Self-Assessment Form

On-Site Monitoring

- Conducted at the research site
- Involves review of ICFs, source documents, safety reporting, Investigational Products, study database and essential documents

Remote Monitoring

- Typically conducted off-site
- Monitor will discuss study conduct with the study team to check on compliance
