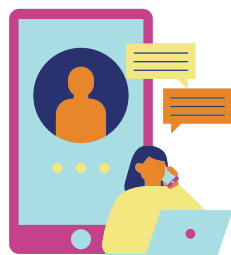
## MIGRATION OF STUDIES
