ROAM, the current DSRB system launched in 2012, will be succeeded by ECOS, a new integrated Ethics and Compliance Online System, in 2024.

ECOS has built in cybersecurity features to protect data access, promote collaborative research conduct and monitoring and leverages on intuitive interfaces to improve user experience.
