DSRB-042012: Updated Disease Specialties Grouping

With effect from **2 November 2012**, the NHG Domain Specific Review Board has updated the disease specialties grouping to include Palliative Medicine (Domain A), Family Medicine (Domain C) and Population Health Research (Domain F).

Domain C will review non organ/disease-specific Family Medicine studies only.

There is also an added clarification that Surgery (Domain D) will include specialties such as General Surgery, Orthopaedic Surgery, Plastic Surgery and Urology.
