

Note for NHG-based MOHH Residents/ Doctors

From 1 October 2020, all NHG-based **MOHH residents/doctors** who are participating in Human Biomedical Research (HBR) studies (approved from 1 November 2019) in the capacity of NHG PI/Co-I or Study Team are required to complete the NHG HBR Minimum Training Requirement i.e. the HBR Essential Research Conduct (ERC) Online V.2 prior to the commencement of involvement in the study.

Note: This also applies when such MOHH residents/ doctors based in NHG institutions are involved in HBR reviewed by other appointed IRBs as a NHG Co-I or Collaborator.

Note:

If you had already completed HBRA minimum training course from SingHealth, NUHS or NUS Cluster or NTU, it will be recognised by NHG. Please file a copy of the training certificate in your Investigator File.
